

## OSCE Simulations for Nurse Practitioners – A Preparatory Course

The course will be offered in a hybrid format, with preparatory material offered online prior the September 7, 2019 one day on-site course focused on application of learning and OSCE simulations.

### Online Course Description

The online portion of the course will be open to registered participants at the beginning of August. The format will be asynchronous and registrants work through the three modules at their own pace. **It is expected that participants complete the modules prior to attending the one day on-site experience.** Content in the on-site experience will build upon the online learning content. The online resources will remain available to participants until mid-October 2019.

#### Module 1 – What to expect in an OSCE

This module will focus on the OSCE process including structure, environment, expectations, evaluation and effective preparation.

#### Module 2 – Working your way through an OSCE

This module will focus on how to perform a focused health history, physical exam, communication of a diagnosis and a therapeutic plan. This module will provide participants a review of techniques and maneuvers for examination of various systems. Tips will be provided on how to perform the required activity within a specific period.

#### Module 3 – Demonstrating appropriate communication and client centered care in an OSCE

This module will focus on how to demonstrate effective communication and engagement of the client, as well as approaches to ensure client centered care.
