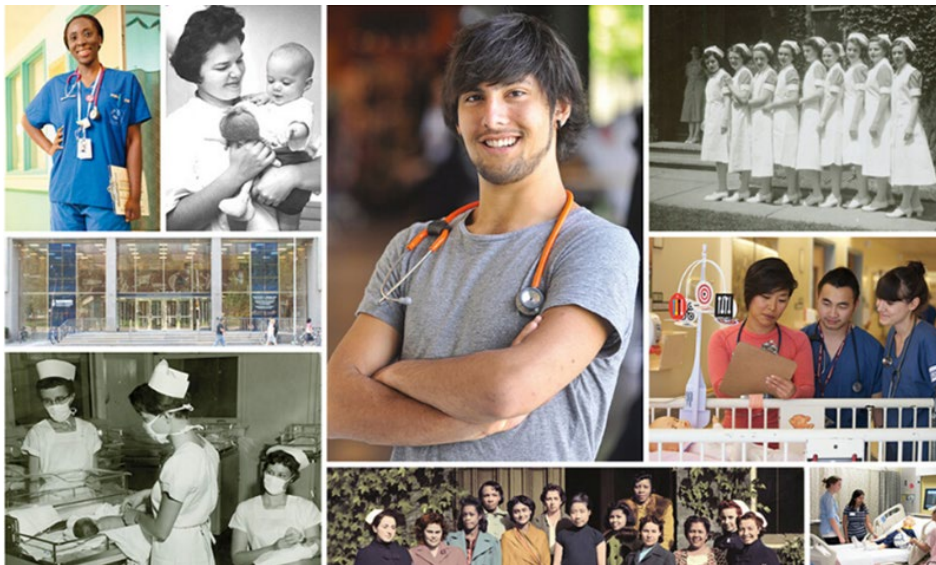

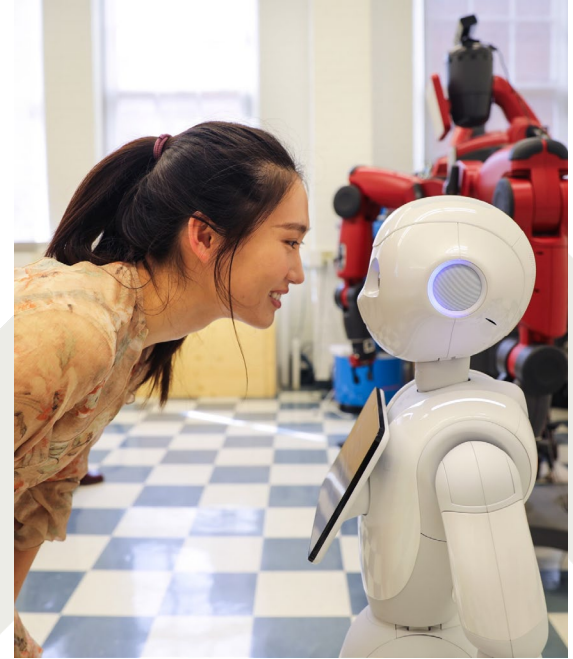

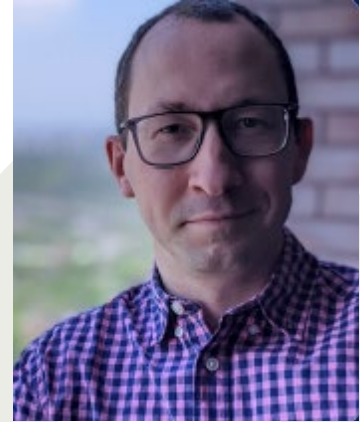

Admission and Eligibility Requirements



Who can apply?



Undergraduate students in the process of completing their second, third or fourth year or graduate students completing their Master's or Doctorate programs



Applicants with an undergraduate degree who are in the workforce and are looking to change career paths

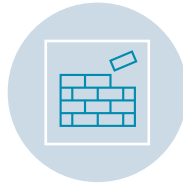


Students from any discipline can apply

Minimum Admission Requirements

*Note: a 1.0 credit is a full-year course at U of T (e.g. starting from September until the following April)

Pre-requisite Courses

Must achieve at least 60%/C-

✓ Courses can be completed at any undergraduate level

✓ You can also combine a 0.5 credit with another 0.5 credit in the same category

1.0 credit in Human Physiology (HP)

or

0.5 credit in HP + 0.5 credit in Human Anatomy

0.5 credit in Statistics

1.0 credit in Life Sciences
or Physical Sciences

1.0 credit in Humanities

1.0 credit in Social
Sciences

0.5 credit in
Microbiology

Required if applying for Sept. 2025.
NOT required if applying for Sept.
2024.



Additional Requirements



Supplementary Application Form

- Personal Statement: strength/skills, interest in nursing/health care
- Leadership/community involvement: volunteer experiences, campus involvement, etc.
- Personal milestones and achievements, lived experiences, etc.
- Available through the Join U of T Portal
- Due date: **February 1, 2024**



Priority Pathway for Indigenous Students

- For applicants who identify as First Nations (status, non-status, treaty or non-treaty), Métis, and Inuit
- Admissions decisions based on individual qualifications rather than in relation to other applicants
- Reviewers include Indigenous community members
- Submit documentation supporting Indigenous identity along with academic and supplementary application
- Two Indigenous Nursing Student Scholarships available: \$10,000 total value over 2 years (\$5,000 per year)

- **Application Fee:** \$90

Award Opportunities

- Approximately 1 in 4 newly admitted BScN student will receive an admission award
- Over \$350,000 in award monies were disbursed in AY 2023-24
- Awards distributed based on academic merit and/or financial need
- Complete one additional form as part of the application process for admission to be considered for all admission awards

Indigenous Tuition Initiative

- The U of T Indigenous Tuition Grant covers the cost of tuition in eligible undergraduate and graduate programs for students from the nine identified First Nations communities
- Indigenous students from the rest of Canada and Native American/Alaska Native students from the continental U.S.A. may be eligible for domestic Ontario tuition fee
