Stremler	COUPN, CASN, CNO, Government  Although the Provincial Government has announced increased funding to expand nursing education, extend the Clinical Extern and Clinical Scholars programs, we have no details on those programs. Our seats for September 2024 intake remain at 100 for the NP program and 231 for the UG program.  TAHSNp is planning a summit to facilitate implementation of the Federal Chief Nurse's Nursing Retention Toolkit which is now is available online in its entirety. TAHSNp is also bringing this forward to the TAHSN CEO table to gain leader-wide buy-in on implementation, with Leigh Chapman and Bloomberg Nursing's Linda McGillis Hall presenting.  The Provincial government announced that the tuition freeze will continue, the effects on budgets at UofT, which anticipated a tuition increase, will be offset by an increase in grants to universities.  LBFON:  Thanks to everyone for your work in ensuring a successful final submission of our UG CNO program approval documentation in response to their initial review of our documents. Thanks also to those of you who continue to work on our CNO program approval process for the NP program.
