Hold a master's degree in nursing or related field or equivalent



Have a minimum B+ standing in your master's degree



Identify a faculty member who has agreed to be your supervisor

Proof of English Facility (if degree is from outside of Canada and English is not the primary language of instruction)



CV with evidence of research experience and resultant scholarly outputs (eg. publications, presentations)



Potential supervisor(s) and why they are a good match

#### Step 2: PhD Admission Application



Once pre-screening is complete, submit through SGS Application Portal:

- CV (plus comment on any gaps)
- Research & Career Plans (research interests, background, career plans, UofT fit, balance)
  - Sample of work
- Two academic references
  - Transcripts

#### PhD Admission: Tips



Acceptance into the program is based on:



High marks (particularly in research courses)





Writing ability



Fit with supervisor

#### Doctor of Nursing (DN) Admission: Requirements



Hold a master's degree in nursing or closelyrelated field



Have a minimum B+ standing in your master's degree



Have a minimum of 2 years relevant healthcare leadership experience or advanced nursing education teaching experience

Be a registered nurse holding current registration in at least one jurisdiction



Identify a faculty member who has agreed to be your supervisor

Research & Career Plans (potential project, background, career plans, leadership/education experience, balance)

- Sample of written work

One academic and two professional/employment references

Transcripts

#### Acceptance into the program is based on:



High marks (particularly in research courses)



Leadership/education experience



Writing ability



Fit with supervisor
