### New Canadian Opportunities

The Registered Nurses' Association of Ontario <u>nursing research interest group</u> grants and scholarship program **application deadline is March 24, 2025**. Multiple awards are available for PhD students and NRIG members.

The <u>Summer Institute on Sustainable Health Systems - CASCADES Canada</u> application deadline is Monday, March 31, 2025. This opportunity is open to trainees (i.e., PhD students) who are interested in the impacts of climate change on human health and health systems. Trainees take part in a weeklong hub where they can network and gain more knowledge in this area. Participation is free and those who prefer to attend virtually will be able to do so.

The <u>IPPH - CReSP Summer Institute</u>: Conducting intervention research with communities to address the structural determinants of health is held in Montreal, Quebec, June 16 to June 19, 2025. **Application deadline is March 31, 2025**. The institute aims to bring together students from across Canada; it is open to postdoctoral fellows or PhD students (who are now conducting dissertation research). Participation is free; Transportation and accommodation will be covered.

The University of Toronto's Emerging And Pandemic Infections Consortium has launched its <u>Ignite Grants</u> competition; **Deadline is April 2, 2025.** Funds available up to \$50,000 / 1 year. The <u>New Connections Grants</u> **application deadline is March 24, 2025.** New connections supports innovative projects developed through collaboration between at least 2 research groups. Funds available: \$100,000 / 2 years.

<u>Arthritis Canada</u> has launched its research funding program. There are several opportunities including **Strategic operating grants** : letter of intent deadline is April 9, 2025; full application (by invitation only) is September 2, 2025.

**Trainee awards** include a postdoctoral fellowship and graduate PhD salary award. Application deadline for both is April 15, 2025.

**STARS career development award**: registration deadline is May 13, 2025; Full application deadline is June 26, 2025.

**Ignite Innovation grants**: abstract registration deadline is May 14, 2025; Full application deadline is June 27, 2025.

The <u>Centre for Aging and Brain Health Innovation Fuel Program</u> offers up to \$500,000 and acceleration services to help late later stage researchers and start up companies achieve research, development, and validation milestones. **Application deadline is April 23, 2025**.

The <u>University of Toronto's Collaborative Centre for Climate, Health + Sustainable Care</u> student training program **application deadline is May 30, 2025**. This non credit certificate program offers specialized training to help students and trainees develop knowledge and expertise in this field. The Centre's <u>graduate fellowship</u> application deadline is also May 30, 2025. Funds available \$10,000. The fellowship supports graduate students to develop their research expertise in sustainability and health.

### New International Opportunities

The Ovarian Cancer Research Alliance grant cycle is now open. Letter of intent deadline is March 26, 2025. Full proposal, by invitation, is due, June 11, 2025. There are 5 opportunities.

- Collaborative research development grant: up to US\$300,000 annually for three years, to a maximum of \$900,000 US total
- Collaborative research development grant in AI: up to US\$300,000 annually for three years, to a maximum of \$900,000 US total
- Early career investigator grant: up to US\$150,000 per year to a maximum of \$450,000 US total.
- Mentored investigator grant: up to US\$100,000 to be used over one or two years
- Health Equity research grant: up to US \$100,000 per year for two years for a maximum of US\$200,000 U.S. I don't know

The <u>National Council for State Boards of Nursing grant program</u> **application deadline is April 1, 2025**. Research priorities include, but are not limited to, outcome studies related to nursing regulation, nursing workforce, substance use disorders in nursing, impact of policy on nursing, and more. Funds available: US\$300,000 for projects to be completed within 12 to 24 months of project start date.

The <u>American Society of Perianesthesia Nurses</u> research grant competition deadline is June **15**, **2025**. There are two funding categories: beginning nurse researcher, with a value of USD500 - 5000 U.S. dollars; experienced nurse researcher, USD3000 to 10,000.

Anticipated timeline: Launch: Spring 2025; application deadline (there may be a registration or expression of interest deadline as well): fall 2025; and funding start date: Winter 2026.

The <u>Health System Impact Fellowship</u> will launch in spring, with a summer deadline. This opportunity is open to doctoral and postdoctoral students, and to non Canadians who hold the award at a Canadian institution. - **Doctoral trainees** receive a one-year experiential learning opportunity where they are embedded in their health system partner organization for at least 60% of their time focused on an impact-oriented project of direct relevance to their partner organization. The remaining time (up to 40%), is protected to continue with their Doctoral program commitments.
- **Postdoctoral researchers** receive a two-year experiential learning opportunity where they are embedded in their health system partner organization for at least 70% of their time focused on their impact-oriented program of work. The remaining time (up to 30%), is protected for academic research.

**Funds Available** 

• HSI Fellowship for Doctoral trainees: The maximum amount per doctoral award is \$50,000 per year for up to 1 year (\$45,000 stipend plus \$5,000 professional development training and research allowance).

 HSI Fellowship for Postdoctoral researchers: The maximum amount per post-doctoral award is \$155,000 total for 2 years (\$70,000 stipend per year, plus \$7,500 professional development training and research allowance per year)

Operating grant: <u>Summer Program In Aging</u> – planning grant. The purpose of this funding opportunity is to identify a host for the 2026 summer program in aging. The strategic topic area will be impact of climate change on the health of older persons. **Application deadline is April 15, 2025**. Funds available: \$150,000, enough to fund one grant. Of this, \$130,000 is dedicated to the organization of the SPA and \$20,000 is dedicated to organizing a 20th anniversary Summer Program in Aging symposium.

The <u>Canadian Heart Function Alliance</u> grants and awards program **application deadline is March 28, 2025**. Trainee awards are available for master's or PhD students and postdoctoral students

The <u>University of Toronto's Provost's Postdoctoral Fellowship</u> **application deadline is April 1, 2025**. Value: up to \$80,000 per year to faculties for up to two years. This competition is open to domestic and international students who identify as Indigenous and/or Black. Interested students should reach out to a prospective supervisor to discuss this opportunity.

The <u>Canadian Research Data Centre Network</u> offers an emerging scholars grant to support PhD students undertaking thesis-related research in a research data centre in Canada. **Applications received from December 1 to March 31:** grants will be awarded by May 15. Applications received from April 1 to July 31: grants will be awarded by September 15. Applications received from August 1 to November 30: grants will be awarded by January 15.

The <u>Canadian Donation and Transplantation Research Program</u> **research grant application deadline is April 1, 2025**. This competition is open to independent researchers working at a Canadian University or research institution. Values are generally around \$30,000 for one year.

<u>AMS Project Grant</u>, for research projects in the history of healthcare and allied disciplines (science and technology studies, etc.). projects must advance the history of health, healthcare and disease, or the education of health professionals. Value: \$20,000. **Application deadline April 2, 2025. AMS** <u>Postdoctoral Fellowship</u> supporting study, analysis and interpretation of past practices, philosophies and/or epistemologies related to human health, healthcare and/or disease or the education of health professionals. Value: \$70,000, plus a \$2,500 research and travel allowance. **Application deadline April 2, 2025**.

**NIHR James Lind Alliance Priority Setting Partnerships:** The UK's National Institute for Health and Care Research seeks to fund studies addressing the James Lind Alliance (JLA) Priority Setting Partnerships' (PSPs) <u>research priorities</u>. **Next application deadline: April 8, 2025** <u>Learn more</u>

<u>GROWW</u> (Guiding interdisciplinary Research On Women's and Girls' health and Wellbeing) cohort program is accepting applications. **Application deadline is April 14, 2025**. This opportunity is open to graduate students

(Master's, PhD), postdoctoral fellows, clinical trainees, and early career researchers at a Canadian university. Partial scholarship support is provided for some students who do not hold a major award (graduate students: \$10,000 / year; postdoctoral fellows: \$20,000 per year).

The <u>Cancer Research Society</u> in collaboration with Ovarian Cancer Canada is offering is the Next Generation Of Scientists Award. **Application deadline is April 22, 2025**. In Part 1 of this competition the postdoctoral fellow must have completed at least two years of postdoctoral training at the time of accepting fellowship. In Part 2 the fellow must obtain a faculty position at a Canadian university or affiliated accredited research centre. Value: the postdoctoral fellowship component is \$50,000 / 1 year; the operating grant component is \$135,000 / 2 years.

The <u>CANStroke Recovery Trials</u> post doctoral fellowship for StrokeGoRed **application deadline is April 23, 2025**. This is a national training competition which will award 2 postdoctoral fellowships valued at up to \$30,000 each.

The Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing <u>Woodend Clinical Education Research Grant</u> is open to master's or doctoral (PhD or DN) students to fund a research project focusing on clinical practice education. Value: \$5,000. **Application deadline: May 2, 2025**. The <u>CASN Pat Griffin Research Grant</u> will support research that addresses 'Nursing Education Outcomes'. The research can focus on all academic levels of nursing education. **Application deadline: May 2, 2025**. Funds Available: up to \$15,000. Eligibility: PI must be faculty at a CASN member school.

**SickKids Community Conference Grants** support conferences, workshops or symposia which are relevant to the health of Canada's children. The purpose of this program is to support events which are organized by and/or for families with children with health challenges. Eligible events will have a focus on information sharing between health professionals, community organizations, and families. Academic conferences are not eligible for funding. There are three deadlines for applications each fiscal year: **May 31**; September 30; and January 31. <u>Apply online</u>

The <u>TRIANGLE</u> program awards competition is now open. **Application deadline is June 1, 2025**. Awards include doctoral awards, early career researcher awards, and postdoctoral awards. TRIANGLE is a training program for researchers in gastroenterology and liver.

The Lung Cancer Research Fund grant program has opened. Leading edge research focuses on basic, translational, clinical, epidemiological, health services, early detection, disparities, and social determinants of health research. Value: \$150,000 over two years. Prevention and early detection in lung cancer focuses on identifying, characterizing and developing approaches and techniques for early detection and/or risk reduction of lung cancer. Value: \$150,000 over two years. Letter of intent due March 3, 2025; full proposal submission (by invitation) due June 2, 2025.

The <u>ResMed Foundation</u> clinical research proposal application deadline is March **15**, **2025**. The Foundation supports sleep disordered breathing research.

The <u>American Association of Nurse Anesthesiology</u> research **grant application deadline is March 31, 2025**. Topics of interest include health care policy, science of anesthesia, education, and more.

<u>Sigma Theta Tau International Grants</u> with an April 1, 2025, application deadline include the Association of Nurses in AIDS Care Grant\*; Hospice and Palliative Nurses Foundation End-of-Life Nursing Care Research Grant, the National Association of Hispanic Nurses Research Grant\*; the Midwest Nursing Research Society Research Grant\*; and the Southern Nursing Research Society Research Grant\*. and/or the Co-sponsoring organization is required. Grant values vary, from US\$2,500 to US\$10,000. Nursing PhD students should check with their supervisor about relevance. The <u>American Association of Heart Failure Nurses Nightingale Research Grants</u> application deadline is April 1, 2025. This grant is open to PhD students – PhD students should discuss relevance with their supervisor, include their supervisor as a Co-Principal Investigator on the grant, and notify the research office of their intent to apply. Value: up to US\$1,000 for 12 months.

The <u>Foundation for Post-acute and Long-term Care Medicine</u> research grant **letter of intent deadline is April 3, 2025.** Full application (by invitation) is due July 15, 2025. Value: Up to US\$25,000. Applicants must be members of the AMDA.

The American Association for the History of Nursing grants for historical research deadline is May 1, 2025.

<u>Sigma Theta Tau International</u> is accepting applications for three grants with a May 1 2025 deadline: The Martha Pitel global nursing research grant has a value of up to us \$10,000 and requires collaboration between at least two countries. This opportunity will not fund research related to prevention, risk reduction, and or early detection of cancer recurrence; basic discovery research; late stage intervention trials; and others. Research areas include a breast cancer pool, cancer in women pool, vaccines pool, and more. Funds available: the maximum amount per grant for Canadian teams is \$400,000 per year for up to five years for a total of \$2,000,000 per grant.

Catalyst Grant: <u>Oral Health Data Analysis</u>. **Registration deadline April 15, 2025, with full application due May 13, 2025**. Funds available: \$1,400,000, enough to fund approximately six grants for up to one year.

<u>SickKids-CIHR-IHDCYH New Investigator Research Grants</u> in Child and Youth Health (2025). Application deadline: April 21, 2025.

### SSHRC /Other Federal Agency Funding Opportunities

The New Frontiers In Research Fund Transformation competition is now open. Notice of intent to apply deadline is April 15, 2025; The letter of intent to apply deadline is June 17, 2025; and the full application deadline is March 3, 2026. Value: minimum \$2,000,000 per year (including indirect costs), to a maximum of \$4 million per year (including direct costs). Duration: six years. The objective is to support large- scale Canadian-LED interdisciplinary research that addresses a major challenge and that have the potential to achieve real and lasting change. The challenge may be fundamental, or applied, with a social, economic, environmental, or health impact.
