New Canadian Opportunities

The Cancer Research Society's **Doctoral Award deadline is April 29, 2025**. Value: \$70,000 over two years.

The <u>Institute for Pandemics Spring 2025 Postdoctoral Fellowships</u> **application deadline is April 30, 2025**. Value: \$70,000 per year plus benefits. Three awards will be made.

The <u>Institute for Pandemics Knowledge Mobilization Grants</u> **application deadline is April 30, 2025**. Value: up to \$5,000 per award; a minimum of six grants will be awarded.

MyRoad (Maximize your Research on Obesity and Diabetes) Health Research Exchange Competition **application deadline for internships is May 1, 2025,** for internships beginning between September 1, 2025, and August 31,

2026, and **October 1, 2025**, for internships between January 1, 2026, and December 31, 2026. This opportunity is open to master's, doctoral or postdoctoral students or early career investigators.

The <u>CAMCCO-L</u>, a CIHR funded **training program** on perinatal research on medications, **application deadline for participation in the one-year curriculum is May 9, 2025**.

The <u>Institute for Work and Health's S. Leonard Syme Research Training Awards</u> in Work and Health for Master's or <u>Doctoral Students</u> have an **application deadline of May 16, 2025.** Typically, up to three awards of \$5,000 each are made.

The <u>Cancer Research Society's Prostate Cancer Research Grant</u> program has launched. Four grants will be awarded; focus is on improving early detection and developing more effective treatments. **Letter of intent deadline is May 28, 2025, with full application due September 9, 2025.**

The Canadian Nurse Educators Institute Fellowship application deadline is May 31, 2025.

The <u>Sigma Theta Tau International</u> opportunity with a June 10, 2025, deadline is the Association of Rehabilitation Nurses Grant. Opportunities with a July 1, 2025, application deadline re: The American Board for Occupational Health Nurses Grant; Doris Bloch Research Award; Joan K. Stout Research Gran, American Nurses Credentialing Center Evidence-based Practice Implementation Grant, and the Dorothy Brooten Transitional Care Research Grant (new). Funding available ranges from U\$\$5,000 to U\$\$20,000. Some opportunities are limited to association or chapter members. Check carefully. New CIHR Opportunities

Notice of upcoming funding opportunity: Strengthening Resilient & Equitable Public Health Systems (STEPS) — Team Grants. Objectives: generate actionable evidence; identify, test and/or evaluate promising system-level solutions; build capacity; foster knowledge mobilization. Research areas: public sector; community sector; Indigenous communities promoting cardiovascular health; public health emergencies and pandemic preparedness. Partners required (there will be a partner linkage tool). Funds available: \$6,750,000, enough to fund approximately nine grants. Maximum amount per team grant: \$250,000 per year for up to three years for a

total of \$750,000 per grant. Anticipated timelines: webinar June 2025; launch June 2025; registration September 2025; and application deadline January 2026.

Notice of upcoming funding opportunity: <u>Emerging Learning Health Systems in Mental Health</u> will fund two national learning health systems in early psychosis intervention and perinatal mental health. Objectives: develop a national LHS, enhance access to services to improve quality of life and more. Anticipated timeline: Launch: Spring 2025; application deadline (there may be a registration or expression of interest deadline as well): fall 2025; and funding start date: Winter 2026.

Notice of upcoming funding opportunity: planning and dissemination grants are anticipated to launch in early April 2025.

The CIHR Institute of Cancer Research is calling for applications for its <u>early career researcher workshop</u>, which will be held at the Canadian Cancer Research Conference in Calgary, Alberta, October 31 and November 1, 2025. **Application deadline is June 23, 2025. Applicants MUST submit an abstract to the conference by the abstract deadline of June 6, 2025.** CIHR-ICR will cover costs associated with travel and accommodation for the ECR workshop plus the 2025 CCRC registration fee. Accommodation will be covered for the duration of the ECR workshop and the 2025 CCRC.

The <u>Health System Impact Fellowship</u> **application deadline is July 7, 2023**. This opportunity is open to doctoral and postdoctoral students, and to non-Canadians who hold the award at a Canadian institution. There is a webinar May 8, 2025, 12pm-1pm ET for prospective applicants. Register Here

- **Doctoral trainees** receive a one-year experiential learning opportunity where they are embedded in their health system partner organization for at least 60% of their time focused on an impact-oriented project of direct relevance to their partner organization. The remaining time (up to 40%) is protected to continue with their Doctoral program commitments.
- Postdoctoral researchers receive a two-year experiential learning opportunity where they are
 embedded in their health system partner organization for at least 70% of their time focused on their
 impact-oriented program of work. The remaining time (up to 30%) is protected for academic research.

Funds Available

- **HSI Fellowship for Doctoral trainees:** The maximum amount per doctoral award is \$50,000 per year for up to 1 year (\$45,000 stipend plus \$5,000 professional development training and research allowance).
- HSI Fellowship for Postdoctoral researchers: The maximum amount per postdoctoral award is \$155,000 total for 2 years (\$70,000 stipend per year, plus \$7,500 professional development training and research allowance per year)

SSHRC /Other Federal Agency Funding Opportunities

The next Partnership Engage Grant application deadline is June 15, 2025 (\$7,000 - \$25,000 for work with a single partner organization, to respond to immediate needs and addressing a specific need); the next Connections Grant (\$7,000 - \$25,000,; outreach activities up to \$50,000; for events and outreach activities; deadline is August 1, 2025. Connection Grants require 50% of the amount requested from their sponsoring organizations. U of T Applicants must meet internal deadlines for both awards (about a week ahead of sponsor deadline).

Competitions with no fixed deadline



<u>NSERC and Mitacs</u> have developed a joint application process for researchers seeking support from both agencies. It is now possible to request support through Mitacs Accelerate internships as part of the full Alliance application.

NSERC Alliance Grants. **Application deadline: No fixed date.** There are two streams: Alliance <u>Advantage</u>: \$20,000 to \$1 million per year for 1-5 years, university researchers collaborate with external organizations to meet partner goals. Alliance <u>Society</u>: \$20,000-\$1 million per year for 1-5 years; university researchers collaborate with partners on projects with societal impact.

Mitacs Accelerate accepts applications throughout the year. The competition is open to doctoral students and postdoctoral fellows. Students partner with a supervising professor and a partner organization to develop a research project. Partner funding is required. Funding begins at \$15,000 for 8 months.

Mitacs Elevate accepts proposals all year round. This is a postdoctoral fellowship with a professional development curriculum component. Value: minimum \$55,000 stipend (partner contributes \$30,000 per year).

GATEWAY

FOR CANCER RESEARCH The <u>Gateway Foundation for Cancer Research</u> accepts grants from researchers around the world on a rolling basis. Successful grant applications are typically funded within 3 to 4 months. A letter of intent is required, and if accepted, applicants have roughly four weeks to submit the full application.

RISING TIDE.

The <u>Rising Tide Foundation for Clinical Cancer Research</u> (Switzerland) accepts letters of intent year-round. Note – matching cash funds are required. Check for eligibility by emailing <u>grants@risingtidefoundation.org</u> before beginning an application.



The <u>Mayday Fund</u> offers grants for research into pain. **There is no deadline; grants are reviewed at the next Trustee's meeting**.

Max Bell Foundation Max Bell Foundation has an ongoing review of grant applications in health and wellness. An LOI is required, and full application is by invitation.

The <u>R. Howard Webster Foundation</u> (Canada) offers funding in the broad areas of Arts & Culture, Education, Environment, Medical, and Social Services. There are no specific deadlines, and once submitted, review and decision process may take up to 6 months.

<u>CANSSI Ontario</u> offers grants of up to \$5,000 to cover covers associated with accessing and working with large data sources. Canssi also offers two grants of up to \$10,000 each to support projects using ICES data. **Applications are accepted on a rolling basis** until two grants have been funded in a given academic year. **Trainees or faculty members** at Ontario-based universities are eligible to apply. Each proposal must include two faculty members from different academic units (at least one from a stats/biostats department). CANSSI also offers funds (\$500-\$1,000) to support Ontario workshop/lecture programs in emerging areas of statistical and data sciences.

The <u>Thrasher Foundation</u> in the US supports children's medical research. <u>E.I. Thrasher awards</u> focus on changing pediatric clinical care. Concept submission deadlines are January 15, 2025, and July 15, 2025. Funds available: grants are not awarded over \$550,000; grant duration: up to three years. Indirect costs of no more than 7% of direct costs are allowed. <u>Farly Career awards</u> focus on development of researchers in child health. The competition is open to physicians or postdoctoral researchers. Concept submission deadlines: March 18, 2025, and September 5, 2025. Maximum funding: \$25,000 in direct costs, for up to two years; indirect costs of no more than 7% of direct costs are allowed. Up to \$12,500 in total may be used for salary of the new researcher.

Canadian Opportunities

The <u>Cancer Research Society</u> in collaboration with Ovarian Cancer Canada is offering is the Next Generation Of Scientists Award. **Application deadline is April 22, 2025**. In Part 1 of this competition the postdoctoral fellow must have completed at least two years of postdoctoral training at the time of accepting fellowship. In Part 2 the fellow must obtain a faculty position at a Canadian university or affiliated accredited research centre. Value: the postdoctoral fellowship component is \$50,000 / 1 year; the operating grant component is \$135,000 / 2 years.

The <u>Centre for Aging and Brain Health Innovation Fuel Program</u> offers up to \$500,000 and acceleration services to help late later stage researchers and start up companies achieve research, development, and validation milestones. **Application deadline is April 23, 2025**.

The <u>CANStroke Recovery Trials</u> post doctoral fellowship for StrokeGoRed **application deadline is April 23, 2025**. This is a national training competition which will award two postdoctoral fellowships valued at up to \$30,000 each.

The Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing Woodend Clinical Education Research Grant is open to master's or doctoral (PhD or DN) students to fund a research project focusing on clinical practice education. Value: \$5,000. Application deadline: May 2, 2025. The CASN Pat Griffin Research Grant will support research that addresses 'Nursing Education Outcomes'. The research can focus on all academic levels of nursing education. Application deadline: May 2, 2025. Funds Available: up to \$15,000. Eligibility: PI must be faculty at a CASN member school.

<u>Arthritis Canada</u> has launched its research funding program. There are several opportunities including **STARS** career development award: registration deadline is May 13, 2025; Full application deadline is June 26, 2025. **Ignite Innovation grants**: abstract registration deadline is May 14, 2025; Full application deadline is June 27, 2025.

The <u>University of Toronto's Collaborative Centre for Climate, Health + Sustainable Care</u> student training program application deadline is May 30, 2025. This non-credit certificate program offers specialized training to help students and trainees develop knowledge and expertise in this field. The Centre's <u>graduate fellowship</u> application deadline is also May 30, 2025. Funds available \$10,000. The fellowship supports graduate students to develop their research expertise in sustainability and health.

SickKids Community Conference Grants support conferences, workshops or symposia which are relevant to the health of Canada's children. The purpose of this program is to support events which are organized by and/or for families with children with health challenges. Eligible events will have a focus on information sharing between health professionals, community organizations, and families. Academic conferences are not eligible for funding. There are three deadlines for applications each fiscal year: **May 31**; September 30; and January 31. <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/journal.

The <u>TRIANGLE</u> program awards competition is now open. **Application deadline is June 1, 2025**. Awards include doctoral awards, early career researcher awards, and postdoctoral awards. TRIANGLE is a training program for researchers in gastroenterology and liver.

The American Association for the History of Nursing grants for historical research deadline is May 1, 2025.

Sigma Theta Tau International is accepting applications for three grants with a May 1, 2025, deadline: The Martha Pitel global nursing research grant has a value of up to us \$10,000 and requires collaboration between at least two countries.
