New Canadian Opportunities

Open Call: the Global Institute of Psychosocial, Palliative & End-of-Life Care has an open call for fellows. This is an unfunded trainee position. Eligible candidates: doctorate or medical specialist or a supervisor affiliated with GIPPEC.

The <u>University of Toronto's Data Sciences Institute Catalyst Grant</u> letter of intent deadline is July 11, 2025. Full application (by invitation) is October 31, 2025. There are two tiers. Tier 1 (development of novel statistical or computational tools or application of existing methodology in innovative ways): Up to \$100,000 for 1-2 years; Tier 2 (projects that align with Tier 1, may also include projects that foster a robust knowledge exchange between data scientists and researchers working in fields where there is identified unmet need to implement advanced data science methods): Up to \$50,000 for 1-2 years. The DSI is partnering with the Edwin WH Leong Centre for Healthy Children to co-fund Catalyst Grants focused on innovative and novel data science in child

health equity. Researchers should indicate they are applying for this grant on the application form's Administrative Information tab.

The <u>Alzheimer Society's Proof of Concept grant</u> **letter of intent deadline is July 21, 2025**. Full application (invitation only) deadline is Monday, November 4, 2025. This grant funds high-risk, high-reward approaches to dementia research. Funds available: \$100,000 maximum that can be held for up to three years.

The <u>Canadian Pain Society</u> is offering an Editorial Review Mentorship Program. Application deadline is July 26, 2025. This is a one-year term, 1-5 hours per month.

<u>Cystic Fibrosis Canada</u> has several grants open; all applications are made through <u>Proposal Central</u> (create an account and search 'cystic fibrosis'). Early career Investigator Awards have a **letter of intent deadline of August 15, 2025**, with full due by October 1, 2025. Seed grants (value up to \$50,000 for one year) have an **application deadline of September 3, 2025**; and the research fellowship (matching funds encouraged) has an **application deadline of October 1, 2025**.

The Marie Sklodowska-Curie Postdoctoral Fellowship application deadline is September 10, 2025.

<u>U of T applicants</u> must have internal approval by September 4, 2025. This fellowship enables European researchers who are members of a member state or associated country to come to a third country (e.g., University of Toronto) for 12-24 months, returning to their original European host for a mandatory 12 months. The EU funds a living allowance, mobility allowance, as well as research, training and networking activities.

New CIHR Opportunities

Notice of upcoming funding opportunity: <u>Strengthening Resilient & Equitable Public Health Systems</u> (STEPS) – Team Grants. Objectives: generate actionable evidence; identify, test and/or evaluate promising system-level

solutions; build capacity; foster knowledge mobilization. Research areas: public sector; community sector; Indigenous communities promoting cardiovascular health; public health emergencies and pandemic preparedness. Partners required (there will be a partner linkage tool). Funds available: \$6,750,000, enough to fund approximately nine grants. Maximum amount per team grant: \$250,000 per year for up to three years for a total of \$750,000 per grant. Anticipated timelines: webinar June 2025; launch June 2025; registration September 2025; and application deadline January 2026.

Notice of upcoming funding opportunity: <u>Emerging Learning Health Systems in Mental Health</u> will fund two national learning health systems in early psychosis intervention and perinatal mental health. Objectives: develop a national LHS, enhance access to services to improve quality of life and more. Objectives: foster creation/strengthening of partnerships between researchers and partners; support time and enablers required for meaningful co-production activities; evaluate co-production activities as part of a learning approach that contributes to the field of knowledge mobilization. Anticipated timelines: Launch: Summer 2025; Application Deadline: Fall 2025; Funding Start Date: Spring 2026.

Upcoming opportunity: <u>Canada Graduate Research Scholarship – Doctoral Program</u>. **Launch**: July 2025. **Application deadline**: TBD – likely early-mid September. **Value**: \$40,000 per year for 36 months. Application is through SSHRC, CIHR or NSERC, depending on subject matter. Eligibility: No more than 36 months of full-time equivalent study in doctoral program. International applicants are eligible; up to 15% of awards will be allotted to international applicants.

Upcoming opportunity: <u>Canada Postdoctoral Research Award Program</u>. **Launch**: July 2025. **Application deadline**: SSHRC September 11, 2025; CIHR and NSERC October 17, 2025. **Value**: \$70,000 per year for two years. International applicants are eligible. Up to 20% of awards will be available to international applicants.

Coming soon: Reviewer in Training Program: Applications will be open July 9 to August 6, 2025. This opportunity offers early career researchers the opportunity to learn about the peer review process at CIHR. There are two tracks: Mentees, who write practice reviews on up to three applications and attend the peer review meeting in full; and ECR reviewers who participate in the same capacity as regular reviewers and review a reduced number of applications.

The <u>CIHR Institute of Aging Betty Havens Prize for Knowledge Mobilization</u> **submission deadline is July 21, 2025**. This award recognizes an individual, team or organization that has advanced the mobilization of research in aging at a local or regional level. Prive Value: \$20,000.

Knowledge Synthesis: Allied Health and Genetics. Registration deadline August 6, 2025, with full application due October 8, 2025. Canadian Opportunities

The Canadian Cancer Society's <u>Emerging Scholar Research Grants Program</u> abstract submission deadline is July **2, 2025, with letter of intent due August 27, 2025.** Full application is by invitation. Value: Up to \$120,000 per year for up to five years. A total of \$9 million is available. The society will fund across the four pillars of health research (biomedical; clinical; health services; and social, cultural, environmental and population health). This competition is open to early career scientists within five years of their first independent appointment.

The <u>Gerontological Nursing Association Ontario</u> Research **grant application deadline is September 1, 2025**, awarded for financial assistance. Value: at discretion of provincial executive. This opportunity open to members only (minimum of three years). Topics: pilot projects, research related to graduate studies (PhD and DN students – include your supervisor on the grant as a co-Principal investigator and check with the research office re: administrative requirements), statistical analysis of previously acquired data sets, and applied clinical

SickKids Community Conference Grants support conferences, workshops or symposia which are relevant to the health of Canada's children. The purpose of this program is to support events which are organized by and/or for families with children with health challenges. Eligible events will have a focus on information sharing between health professionals, community organizations, and families. Academic conferences are not eligible for funding. The CIHR Institute of Cancer Research is calling for applications for its <u>early career researcher workshop</u>, which will be held at the Canadian Cancer Research Conference in Calgary, Alberta, October 31 and November 1, 2025. **Application deadline is June 23, 2025. Applicants MUST submit an abstract to the conference by the abstract deadline of June 6, 2025.** CIHR-ICR will cover costs associated with travel and accommodation for the ECR workshop plus the 2025 CCRC registration fee. Accommodation will be covered for the duration of the ECR workshop and the 2025 CCRC.

The <u>Health System Impact Fellowship</u> application deadline is July 3, 2023.  embedded in their health system partner organization for at least 70% of their time focused on their

By September 30, 2025, NIH may issue awards to foreign recipients directly as an independent subproject; primary institutions will no longer be able to issue foreign subawards. Effective May 1, 2025, NIH will not issue notices of awards for anything when a foreign subaward entity is included, and foreign co-applicants are no longer permitted on NIH applications until the new awards structure is in place.
