New Canadian Opportunities

<u>The Alzheimer Society of Canada</u> research competition **application deadline is November 3, 2025**. <u>Funding opportunities include</u> <u>doctoral</u> and postdoctoral awards; new investigator operating grant; and proof of concept grant.

The <u>Kidney Foundation</u> Allied Health Kidney Research Grants **application deadline is November 3, 2025**. The Allied Health Kidney <u>Doctoral Fellowships</u> **application deadline is November 3, 2025**. Funds available: \$31,000 per year for up to two years (must reapply for second year of award).

The <u>Canadian Hemophilia Society – Novo Nordisk Canada Psychosocial Research Program</u> is open to professionals/graduate students from the allied health disciplines. Funds available: \$20,000 per grant; a maximum of two grants at \$20,000 will be funded. Graduate Students at U of T must include their supervisor as a co-principal investigator. Application deadline is November 28, 2025.

The American Association of Critical-Care Nurses Research Impact Grant application deadline is October 24, 2025. Funds available: US\$50,000. This grant is open to AACN members (including graduate students; U of T Graduate students must include their supervisor as co-principal investigator). The AACCN STTI grant application deadline through STTI is October 27, 2025. Funds available: US\$10, 000. Reminder: PhD students must include their supervisor as a co-Principal investigator on all grants. Let your research office know in order to meet administrative requirements.

<u>Cancer Research UK in association with Stand Up To Cancer</u> is offering a grant on data for children's and young people's cancer. **Outline application deadline is November 27, 2025**. This award will fund data/Al-driven approaches that answer cancer research questions addressing cancers in children and young people. Funds available: up to £2.5 million for up to five years.

New CIHR Opportunities

Notice of upcoming funding opportunity: <u>Advancing 2S/LGBTQI+ health through research</u> will advance research to address health needs, inequities and strengths of the community, broaden and strengthen engagement in 2S/LGBTQI+ health research, strengthen research and community capacity, and support knowledge mobilization strategies. <u>Anticipated timeline</u>: <u>Launch November 2025</u>. <u>Registration February 2026</u>, <u>Application deadline March 2026</u>.

Notice of upcoming funding opportunity: <u>CIHR Research Excellence</u>, <u>Diversity</u>, <u>and Independence</u> (<u>REDI</u>) early career transition award 2025. This two-phase program will support trainees from underrepresented groups. Awards begin seeking an independent research position during mentored Phase 1 and are expected to transition to this position in Phae 2, within 3 years of the funding start date. Stream A is for trainees who self-identify as Black (any gender), racialized women, or racialized gender-diverse people; Stream B is for trainees who self-identify as First Nations, Inuit, Métis (any gender). CIHR will host webinar and a partner linkage tool. Funds available: \$34,500,000, enough to fund approximately 50 awards and 50 community engagement and knowledge mobilization supplements. Maximum amount per award is anticipated to be \$90,000 per year for up to three years (\$70,000 per year for the stipend, \$20,000 per year for the research allowance); and followed by \$120,000 per year for up to three years. \$1,500,000 is available in the KM supplementary funding; each applicant can receive up to \$5,000 per year in additional funding for up to six years. **Anticipated timeline:**Launch early October 2025; info session #1 November 2025; info session #2 late January 2026; Q& A session for applicants March 2026, application deadline June 2026.

Notice of upcoming funding opportunity: <u>Beyond treatment – advancing cancer survivorship team grants</u>. The objectives of this funding opportunity are to advance understanding risks and developments of late and long-term toxicities and complications, and identify strategies to improve survivorship care (re: host, lifestyle, environmental, social and other intersectional factors), foster and enable interdisciplinary team science, bridge the gap between research and practice, and strengthen research capacity in the field. Research areas include breast cancer survivorship, indigenous peoples' health, pediatric cancer survivorship, reproductive and sexual health in breast cancer survivorship, and more. There will be webinars (date TBD). Funds available: \$18,000,000, enough to fund approximately nine team grants. Maximum per grant is anticipated to be \$400,000 per year for up to five years for a total of \$2,000,000 per grant. **Anticipated timeline: webinar fall 2025/winter 2026; launch fall 2025, registration winter 2026, application summer 2026.**

Catalyst Grant: <u>Digital Health</u>. **Registration deadline December 16, 2025, with full application due March 17, 2025.** Funds available: \$1,000,000, enough to fund approximately ten grants. Maximum amount: \$100,000 for up to one year.

SSHRC /Other Federal Agency Funding Opportunities

<u>Knowledge Synthesis Grants</u>: The Arts Transformed. **Application deadline December 2, 2025**. Value \$30,000 per grant for one year.

<u>Partnership Engage Grant</u>: **Application deadline: December 15, 2025**. U of T applicants must meet internal deadlines of approximately 1 week before. Value: \$7,000 to \$25,000.

Competitions with no fixed deadline

<u>NSERC and Mitacs</u> have developed a joint application process for researchers seeking support from both agencies. It is now possible to request support through Mitacs Accelerate internships as part of the full Alliance application.

NSERC Alliance Grants. **Application deadline: No fixed date.** There are two streams: Alliance <u>Advantage</u>: \$20,000 to \$1 million per year for 1-5 years, university researchers collaborate with external organizations to meet partner goals. Alliance <u>Society</u>: \$20,000-\$500,000 per year for 1-5 years; university researchers collaborate with partners on projects with societal impact. International Collaboration grants program is paused as of May 20, 2025 at 8 pm and expected to reopen Winter 2025-2026. Beginning December 1, 2025, the <u>Public Value Impact Proposition Selection Committee</u> will be expanded and will not only assess applications for fit, but will also provide funding recommendations following merit assessment of each application.

<u>Mitacs Accelerate</u> accepts applications throughout the year. The competition is open to doctoral students and post-doctoral fellows. Students partner with a supervising professor and a partner organization to develop a research project. Partner funding is required. Funding begins at \$15,000 for 8 months.

<u>Mitacs Elevate</u> accepts proposals all year round. This is a postdoctoral fellowship with a professional development curriculum component. Value: minimum \$55,000 stipend (partner contributes \$30,000 per year).

The <u>Gateway Foundation for Cancer Research</u> accepts grants from researchers around the world on a rolling basis. Successful grant applications are typically funded within 3 to 4 months. A letter of intent is required, and if accepted, applicants have roughly four weeks to submit the full application.

The <u>Rising Tide Foundation for Clinical Cancer Research</u> (Switzerland) accepts letters of intent year-round. Note — matching cash funds are required. Check for eligibility by emailing <u>grants@risingtide-foundation.org</u> before beginning an application.

The <u>Mayday Fund</u> offers grants for research into pain. **There is no deadline; grants are reviewed at the next Trustee's meeting**.

<u>Max Bell Foundation</u> has an ongoing review of grant applications in health and wellness. An LOI is required, and full application is by invitation.

The <u>R. Howard Webster Foundation</u> (Canada) offers funding in the broad areas of Arts & Culture, Education, Environment, Medical, and Social Services. There are no specific deadlines, and once submitted, review and decision process may take up to 6 months.

<u>CANSSI Ontario</u> offers grants of up to \$5,000 to cover covers associated with accessing and working with large data sources. Canssi also offers two grants of up to \$10,000 each to support projects using ICES data. **Applications are accepted on a rolling basis** until two grants have been funded in a given academic year.

Trainees or faculty members at Ontario-based universities are eligible to apply. Each proposal must include two faculty members from different academic units (at least one from a stats/biostats department). CANSSI also offers funds (\$500-\$1,000) to support Ontario workshop/lecture programs in emerging areas of statistical and data sciences.

Open Call: the Global Institute of Psychosocial, Palliative & End-of-Life Care has an open call for fellows. This is an unfunded trainee position. Eligible candidates: doctorate or medical specialist or a supervisor affiliated with GIPPEC.

Canadian Opportunities

The University of Toronto's Data Sciences Institute <u>Data Access Grant</u> application deadline is September 26, 2025. Value: \$10,000 for up to 8 months. This grant covers the costs of accessing data – specifically, costs for a data access fee, but applications can also include for costs such as data transfer. Personnel costs are ineligible.

The <u>Joint Federal Research Funding Program for Military Personnel and Veterans</u> has two funding opportunities. The first is an environmental scan of specialized health services for diverse populations within Canada. Value: \$40,000. **Application deadline is September 26, 2025.** The second is Investigating the role and trainability of self-compassion in mitigating moral injury among Canadian Armed Forces personnel. Value: Up to \$100,000 (only one grant will be awarded). **Application deadline is October 10, 2025**.

The 2026/2027 Heart & Stroke Research competitions are now open. Competitions include:

- Postdoctoral fellowships awards deadline is October 2, 2025; Value: Up to \$140,000 for up to two years
- Personnel awards for women's heart and brain health for doctoral (up to \$40,000 per year for up to three years) and postdoctoral (up to \$70,000 per year for two years) students is **October 2, 2025.**

The <u>Cystic Fibrosis Canada</u> research fellowship (matching funds encouraged) has an **application deadline of October 1, 2025**.

MyRoad (Maximize your Research on Obesity and Diabetes) Health Research Exchange Competition **application deadline for internships is October 1, 2025,** for internships between January 1, 2026, and December 31, 2026. This opportunity is open to master's, doctoral or postdoctoral students or early career investigators.

The <u>Inlight Student Mental Health</u> initiative fellowship application system is open now. **Submission deadline is October 1, 2025**. There is a webinar on September 9, 2025, at 12 noon eastern. Value: \$500.

<u>Kids Brain Health Network</u> is calling for proposals for the 2025 Innovation and Implementation program. **Submission deadline is October 3, 2025.** Matching funding (1:1) required. The agency has made the <u>information</u> webinar available on YouTube.

The <u>Canadian Cancer Society Challenge Grant</u> competition abstract registration deadline is October 8, 2025. Relevance review results are October 31, 2025, with full applications due January 28, 2026. Research priorities are Prevent (e.g., cancer risk reduction); Detect (e.g., screening); Care (e.g., equitable access, quality of life); Champion (equitable access).

International Opportunities

The <u>Beryl Institute's Patient Experience Grant and Scholar Programs</u> deadline is September 26, 2025. Value \$1,000. The focus is on the value and impact of focusing on the patient experience; improving the volume to knowledge; building knowledge. This opportunity is open to the Institute's Members

The American Association of Nurse Anesthesiology deadline for general and dedicated research grants is September 30, 2025. Topics of interest include healthcare policy, science of anesthesia, education, practice/clinical, leadership, and diversity, equity and inclusion. Open to members only.

The <u>National Council of State Boards of Nursing</u> (US) **grant application deadline is October 3, 2025**. Submissions should address research priorities, which include but are not limited to nursing workforce issues; nursing regulation; recent technologies related to nursing.

<u>Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation Innovation Grant</u> letter of intent deadline is October 15, 2025. The grant focus must be on childhood cancer and have potential for major scientific and/or clinical impact in pediatric oncology. Funds available: maximum US\$125,000 per year for a maximum of two years. Maximum allowable grant: US\$250,000.

The <u>Horowitz Foundation for Social Policy Awards Competition</u> **application deadline is December 1, 2025**. Eligibility: <u>Doctoral students</u>. Value: US\$10,000. The Foundation supports policy research by emerging scholars whose work addresses contemporary issue sin the social sciences.

Sigma Theta Tau International (US) is accepting applications for the small grants; Alpha Eta Collaborative Research Grant; Council for the Advancement of Nursing Science Grant; Rosemary Berkel Crisp research Award; Western Institute of Nursing Research Grant (application deadline for all is December 1, 2025). PhD students at U of T are not eligible to hold funds in their own name; if intending to apply should consult with their supervisor about relevance and eligibility, notify the research office, and include their supervisor on the application. Funds available vary; check eligibility carefully.

<u>Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation Young Investigator Grant</u> **application deadline is December 11, 2025**. Translational and clinical research projects are encouraged. Proposals must be focused on childhood cancers. Funds available: US\$60,000 per year for a maximum of three years.

CIHR Grant Opportunities

Team Grant: Strengthening Resilient & Equitable Public Health Systems (STEPS). Registration deadline is September 17, 2025, with full application due January 14, 2026. Objectives: generate actionable evidence; identify, test and/or evaluate promising system-level solutions; build capacity; foster knowledge mobilization. Research areas: public sector; community sector; Indigenous communities promoting cardiovascular health; public health emergencies and pandemic preparedness. Partners required (there will be a partner linkage tool). Funds available: \$6,750,000, enough to fund approximately nine grants. Maximum amount per team grant: \$250,000 per year for up to three years for a total of \$750,000 per grant.

The <u>Canada Postdoctoral Research Award Program</u> **application deadline is September 17, 2025**. <u>Priority announcement areas are Aging</u>; Sex and Gender in Health Research; and Pandemic Preparedness and Health Emergencies Research. Value: \$70,000 per year for up to two years.

The Institute of Human Development, Child and Youth Health Talks competition is open until September 25, 2025. Share a clear evidence-based message with a general audience that will impact the health of children, youth and families via any of three categories: videos, infographics, and podcasts. Prize money: first place: \$3,500; second place: \$3,000; third place: \$2,500.

The <u>Doctoral Research Award: Canada Graduate Research Scholarship 2025-2026</u> is now open. <u>Internal deadlines apply, check with your department</u>. Value: \$40,000 per year for up to 3 years. This opportunity is open to international students. Applicants must have completed no more than 36 months of full-time equivalent study in the doctoral program by December 31 of the calendar year of application. <u>Full eligibility information here</u>. <u>Priority announcement areas</u> are Ageism (Geroscience); Bioinformatics and Computational Biology; Lung health in Indigenous populations (e.g., lung cancer, COPD, asthma, harm reduction activities); Pandemic preparedness and health emergencies research (behavioural sciences; health systems research; one health; community-based research approaches intervention research and implementation science; and infectious disease modeling); and sex and gender in health research (advancing intersectionality; sex and gender science for health equity in priority communities; understanding sex and gender mechanisms and processes). <u>IMPORTANT: The CIHR ResearchNet portal will close to applicants on September 30, 2025.</u> <u>Nursing applicants must submit their application by September 23, 2025.</u>

Catalyst Grant: 2025-2026 Partnering for Impact – Catalyst Grant. Application deadline: October 23, 2025.. Funds available: \$4,750,000; enough to fund 31-38 grants. Up to \$125,000 available per grant for up to one year, and possibility for an additional \$25,000 to ensure meaningful involvement of communities or populations that require additional resources to reach. Pools: General; Patient-oriented research; Centre for Research on Pandemic Preparedness and Health Emergencies; Institute of Health Services and Policy Research focused on primary care; Institute of Neurosciences, Mental Health and Addiction; Institute of Population and Public Health (re: global health, climate justice, SDOH and public health); Employment and Social Development Canada (re: Impacts of school food programming).

<u>Canada Graduate Research Scholarships – Doctoral Program (SSHRC).</u> Students currently enrolled at a university will have to meet an internal deadline, mid-late September. Value: \$40,000 per year for up to three years.

Nursing applicants must submit their application by October 1, 2025.

<u>Insight Grant</u> application deadline is October 1, 2025 (University of Toronto applicants must submit an internal administrative approval by noon on Thursday September 25, 2025, and full application must be uploaded to the SSHRC website by 9 am Monday, September 29, 2025). Stream A funds \$10,000 - \$125,000; Stream B funds \$125,001 - \$500,000. The <u>University of Toronto is offering a webinar on Strategies for Success</u> on August 26, 2025, 10:30 am – 12 noon.

Indigenous Innovation and Leadership in Research Network Grants. Application deadline: October 21, 2025. Stage 1: up to \$75,000 for one year; Stage 2 (invitation only): up to 1.75 million for four years. This grant will support a wide range of interdisciplinary research and research training in First Nations and Métis communities that will increase Indigenous leadership and capacities in research; decolonize Indigenous research.

The next <u>Connection Grant</u> (\$7,000 - \$25,000; outreach activities up to \$50,000; for events and outreach activities) **deadline** is **November 1, 2025**. Connection Grants require 50% of the amount requested from their sponsoring organizations. U of T Applicants must meet internal deadlines for both awards (about a week ahead of sponsor deadline).

Partnership Development Grant application deadline is November 17, 2025. **U of T applicants must submit an MRA by noon, November 5, 2025, and the full application by 9 am, November 12, 2025**. Funds available: \$75,000 to \$200,000 over one to three years. Grant goal: develop research and /or related activities by fostering new partnerships with existing and/or potential partners; or design and test new partnership approaches.
